### Step 1

Visit our Summer Programme website and find out which programme you are interested

### Step 2

Attend our General Briefing to receive more information about application and sponsorship

### Step 3

Attend our Summer Programme Fair on 16 January

#### Step 6

Announce Result: 28 Feb

#### Step 5

Application period: 17 January to 15 February (Decide how many smart point you would like to use)

#### Step 4

Online Application starts on 17 January (application link will be available on our website)

## Step 7 attend the programme.

Confirm with SAO that you will Submit required documents through the link sent by SAO

## Step 8

Confirmation Period: 1 – 8 March \*\*Late confirmation will not be accepted

### Step 9

Submit your application to the Host University OR to SAO (depends on the programme you applied) and pay the tuition/other fees by deadline

#### Step 12

Contact Faculty directly if you would like to earn transfer credits

#### Step 11

After you get accepted, you may start planning your trip (air tickets, visa, etc)

### Step 10

Attend Pre-Departure Briefing on 20 March. SAO will prepare a letter of selection for you to apply for visa

## After you return to Macau

- All participants will need to complete the online survey provided by SAO
- For students who receive Smart Point, RC or University Team sponsorship, a trip report together with relevant documents are required in order to claim the sponsorship

# Important Notes

- Student and parent agreement
- Financial situation & safety assessment
- Purpose of the trip
- Contact Faculty directly for credit transfer issues
- Apply Visa (簽證) and purchase air tickets on your own
- Travel Insurance is mandatory
- Fulfill SAO's requirements
  - Attend briefings
  - Submit all the required documents and reports
  - Complete the programme



## **Penalties and Disciplinary Actions**

- Withdraw from the programme after confirmation (8 March, 2019)
  - did not complete the official application
  - did not complete the programme
- Student will be subjected to an administrative fee of MOP1000 (by cashier order/ bank draft) or disciplinary actions. Student will have to return the full sponsorship (if granted)
- Unless justifications are provided and approved by Student Affairs Office

# **Smart Point Sponsorship**

Programme Type	Sponsorship
Programme Type : G1 (Programme Fee < MOP 20,000)	≤MOP 7,000
Programme Type : G2 (Programme Fee : MOP20,001-30,000)	≤MOP 11,000
Programme Type : G3 (Programme Fee : MOP>30,001)	≤MOP 15,000

- Programme <u>nomination</u> and the <u>allocation of sponsorship</u> will be based on your accumulated Smart Point
- Programme Type and Fee refers to the sum of tuition and accommodation fees announced by the host university
- For programme with **limited quota**, when student does not have enough points to receive sponsorship, their smart points will still be deducted to get into the programme
- An extra MOP 500 will be given to those who receive Smart Point sponsorship and have an accumulated GPA >= 3.0 at the same time
- In summer 2018, 33 students received sponsorship under Smart Point Scheme
- SAO reserves the right to change the programme type/sponsorship based on the actual expenses after the trip

2018 Median: 58.5 (For reference only)
Sponsorship only covers 70% OR MOP 15,000 of the student's total expenses which include:

- prorgramme/tuition fee
- accommodation fee
- air tickets
